This will include running recurrent monthly meetings with the Leads, supporting them as they engage executive sponsors from each of the member companies, securing re-commitment for membership from the companies, and onboarding new member companies.

What You'll Be Doing:

- Support Member Company Leads as they engage Exec sponsors to secure membership commitment year on year
- Collaborate with other Pillars to prepare materials for exec sponsors (e.g. add to the quarterly roundtable with exec sponsors)

- Develop a process to monitor engagement and event attendance from member companies, and improve this, as needed
- Maintain materials used by member companies
